


Test and Trace Self-Isolation Payments: Schools to liaise with parents on these as required



been told to self-isolate for 10 days

Staff members or students can return to school if they are well, with no fever for 48 hours\*

\*If staff member / student has previously been identified as a close contact of someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 (and has entered this flowchart via scenario 3 or 4), they still need to complete the 10-day isolation period. They can return to school after 10 days if they are well and have had no fever for 48 hours.

## What is a contact?

A 'contact' is a person who has been close to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 anytime from 2 days before the person was symptomatic up to 10 days from onset of symptoms (this is when they are infectious to others). For example, a contact can be:

- people who spend significant time in the same household as a person who has tested positive for COVID-19
- a person who has had face-to-face contact (within one metre), with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, including:
  - being coughed on
  - having a face-to-face conversation within one metre
  - having skin-to-skin physical contact, or
  - o contact within one metre for one minute or longer without face-to-face contact
- a person who has been within 2 metres of someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 for more than 15 minutes
- a person who has travelled in a small vehicle with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or in a large vehicle or plane near someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.

Any students or staff members who go on to develop symptoms should inform the school as soon as possible and the school should return to the start of this flowchart.

NHS Test and Trace/Public Health England will work with the school to implement any further measures.

After 10 days, if children or staff members do not develop symptoms, they can return to school.
